Baptist Union of PNG timely Delivered of Relief Assistant Supplies to Yambali Landside affected Community at Mulitaka in Porgera District in Enga Province

Baptist Union of PNG timely delivery of relief supplies, Food Items and Non-Food Items to the community affected by massive landslide at Yambali Community in Mulitaka LLG, Porgera – Paiala District in Enga Province through the Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) Program.

We delivered relief supplies including food items; 200 Rice bags, 200 Maggi Noodles cartoons, 100 Tinned Fish Cartoons and Garden food including 5x Kaukau bags and 5x Potato Bags. Non-Food items including; shelter kit, Bedding and Wash Kit, Safety Equipment's and Tools.

The delivery was done at Yambali Care Center where the affected communities were camped. Every affected population including women, children, girls, mothers, fathers and venerable people received relief supplies accordingly.

The community leaders and mothers from the Yambali really appreciates and thanked the Baptist Union of PNG to delivery relief supplies on time when they were in really need of food. One woman really happy and made an appreciative statement as quoted below.

“We were without food for two days. The food that was delivered by other agencies were finished some days ago. Everyone in the Care Center were hungry and we mothers decided to go out to neighboring tribes to do volunteer work in their garden to at least they can provide us with some Kaukaus so we can survive for next couple of days. However, Baptist Union came in with truck load of food and I am really proud of your Baptist Union. You are really saving our live. I was in tears when I show the truck load of food came into the care center. Thank God for saving our life”

Few fathers and the leaders from the camp also made similar statements. The delivery of relief supplies was done successfully.

The relief supplies for Enga Landslide Disaster Emergency Response were funded by Australian Government through the Australian Humanitarian Program (AHP) and through the CAN DO partners. BU received funds through CAN DO partners to provide relief assistance to the landslide affected population.
